Among his earlier positions were: Professor, Evaluation studies, Utrecht University, the Netherlands (1992-2005); Chief-Inspector, Inspectorate for Education, the Netherlands (2000-2003); Dean, Humanities & social sciences Faculty, Netherlands Open University (1995-2000); Director, Performance Auditing and Evaluation, Netherlands National Audit Office (1987-1995); Associate Professor, Policy Research, Leiden University (1978-1987).

He was President of the European Evaluation Society (1999-2002) and of the Dutch Evaluation Society (2004-2011). Member of Evaluation Journals editorial boards, EU Evaluation Reviewer and many other functions. Recent publications appeared in Evaluation, the Utrecht Law Review, the European Journal of Criminal Policy and Research, the American Journal of Evaluation and in the Zeitschrift für Evaluation.
