Inge De Wolf

Professor in Education Systems at Maastricht university

Inge De Wolf is a professor in Education Systems at Maastricht university (the Netherlands). She is specialized in educational evaluation, system level evaluation, policy evaluation and empirical evaluation methods. In her research she combines sociological and economic evaluation methods in order to find out 'what works in education'. Prof. De Wolf is also initiator of the 'academic workplace in education', a Dutch research network of teachers, school principals, policy makers, school inspectors and academics. And she is responsible for the State of Education, a yearly evaluation study of the strong and weak aspects of the Dutch education system. This State of Education is made by the Inspectorate of Education, where prof. De Wolf also works, and discussed in the Dutch House of Representatives.
