Professor of Public Economics at the University of Milan

Massimo Florio is Professor of Public Economics at the University of Milan. He has been awarded a Jean Monnet Chair of Economics of European Integration, an 'Ad Personam' Jean Monnet Chair in EU Industrial Policy, and he currently is the coordinator of a Jean Monnet Network of six European universities. He has been involved in evaluations for the EC, the European Parliament, the EIB, the OECD, the World Bank and other institutions. Founder and honorary president of CSIL Centre for Industrial Studies, Florio has been the scientific director of the EC "Guide to Cost-benefit analysis of investment projects".

His recent books include "Network Industries and Social Welfare" (OUP 2013), "Applied Welfare Economics" (Routledge 2014), and two edited books: "The economics of infrastructure provisioning" (MIT Press 2015), "Infrastructure finance in Europe" (OUP 2016). His current research interests include the evaluation of the impact of research infrastructures, particularly at CERN (forthcoming in "Technological Forecasting and Social Change").
