Prof. Olivier Chosidow

Olivier CHOSIDOW is Professor of Dermatology and past chair of the Department of Dermatology at the University Paris-est Creteil, Henri Mondor Hospital, Creteil, France. Dermatologist since 1987, he obtained his PhD in clinical pharmacology in 1995 and graduated in clinical epidemiology in 1997. He was President of the FSD in 2013-2014, is an external advisor of the ILDS-WHO committee and belongs to the IACS (International Alliance for the Control of Scabies) steering committee. He received an EADV clinical care award in 2015 and an ILDS certificate of appreciation in 2016. He is Deputy editor of PLoS NTD and President of the Infectious and STD French working Group "GrIDIST".

As a clinician researcher, he authored 547 articles and delivered 580 talks at the national, European and international level. His interests include Skin Infectious Diseases, including ectoparasitic disease with several reviews/editorials (Lancet 2000, NEJM 2006, NEJM 2012), book chapters (Rook's), RCTs showing clinical pyrethoid resistance to head lice (Lancet 1994) and value of oral ivermectin (NEJM 2010). He supported the development of the porcine model of scabies and is presently involved in 3 RCTs, including i) the evaluation of high doses of ivermectin in crusted scabies and ii) moxidectin in common scabies.
