Prof. Henning Hamm

Henning Hamm completed his residency and received his postdoctoral lecture qualification at the Department of Dermatology, University Hospital Münster, Germany, under the directorship of Egon Macher in the 1980s. Initially specialized in dermatological surgery he was early influenced by his medical teacher Rudolf Happle and gained increasing interest in hair diseases and genodermatoses. Already during his residency he actively participated in the first ESPD congress in 1984 in Münster. In 1992, he was appointed professor and assistant medical director at the Department of Dermatology, University Hospital Würzburg, Germany, headed by Eva-B. Bröcker and later by Matthias Goebeler. Here, he pursued and broadened his practical experience in pediatric dermatology with a special interest in genodermatoses, nevi, cutaneous tumors, skin infections and psoriasis in children. From the beginning, he is a member of the ESPD and the German Working Group of Pediatric Dermatology which he chaired from 2016 to 2019.
