Dr. Alexios Alexopoulos

Dr. Alexios Alexopoulos graduated from the 'National and Kapodistrian' Medical School of Athens University (Greece) in the year 2000. He qualified as a consultant in General Pediatrics in 2008. Afterwards, he was trained in Pediatric Dermatology at 'Great Ormond Street Hospital For Sick Children' in London/UK and continued his training in the Pediatric Dermatology Unit at 'Agia Sofia Children's Hospital' of Athens.

Dr Alexopoulos worked as a University Scholar at 'Aghia Sophia Children's Hospital' of Athens for nearly a decade with dedicated duties in the field of Pediatric Dermatology, presenting research, clinical and teaching work. He completed his thesis entitled 'Aquagenic Wrinkling of the Palms in Cystic Fibrosis Patients' in the field of Pediatric Dermatology.
