Christine Bodemer, MD, PhD

Christine Bodemer, MD, PhD is the head of the Department of Dermatology, Necker Enfants Malades Hospital, and Professor in Dermatology at Paris University, Paris France.

She coordinates the French National Reference Centre for Genodermatoses, MAGEC, the French National Network for Rare Skin Diseases FIMARAD, and the European network for rare skin diseases, ERN-Skin.

She has been President of the French Society of Paediatric Dermatology and President of the Genodermatoses committee of the Fondation René Touraine, secretary of the European Society of Paediatric Dermatology (ESPD) and currently she is a member of the scientific committee of the ESPD, and a member of the board of directors of the International Society of Pediatric Dermatology (ISPD)

Her main field of competence is Paediatric Dermatology, with a long lasting interest in rare skin disorders and particularly in genodermatoses and inflammatory skin diseases. She took part in the redaction/diffusion of French and European guidelines, organized several international trainings and, since 2003, pursues a work of organization of a network on the rare skin diseases (First clinical network in Mediterranean and Middle-Eastern countries; ERN pilot project: Together Against Genodermatoses) with currently the organization and coordination of the European Rare Skin Diseases Network. She has been the president of the ESPD congress in Paris in 2016, and is currently organizing the 1st International Congress for Rare Skin Diseases, with the support of ERN-Skin and the René Touraine Foundation which will take place in Paris in February 2022
